Vestry gave their approval to move forward to the next steps which will involve participation of other groups like the Finance Committee and the Communications Committee. - Richard Simpson has done a great job of organizing the recognition event for Ralph Paragg and his tireless work helping refugees. The event is sure to be a success and is planned for Saturday, October 5.
- Rod Ashley, Oludare Adedeji, and Deacon Susan Page attended the Anglican Lutheran National Worship Conference held in Regina in July.
