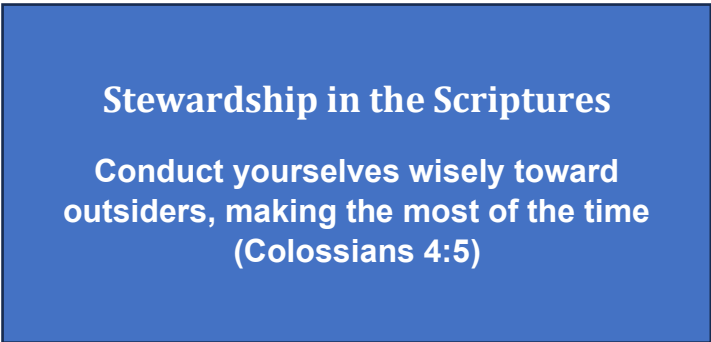
Front Lawn Redevelopment
